<u>Spellings</u>

<u>Reading</u>

The children are able to change their books as and when they are finished with their previous one. It is essential that the children write in their records every time they read. The children are expected to read and write this in their records as often as possible as this has a huge impact on their reading and own writing.

We are now completing more and more evidence-based questions within our reading, and lots of us are finding this quite tricky, so any questions you can ask when you child reads to you to check their understanding would be a huge help.

In English this term we will focus on the following:
