English

In English this term, we will be studying a variety of texts including 'Little Red Riding Hood', a recount about a trip to the woods and firework/Christmas poetry.

We will be learning to write in full sentences using capital letters and full stops.

The children will be learning how to correctly form their individual letters including a lead in and out whilst keeping each letter separate.

<u>PE</u>

PE will be on a **Monday.** Please ensure that your child comes dressed in their **school** PE kit on Mondays. **They will stay in their PE kits all day**. Earrings should not be worn on this day and long hair should be tied back.

<u>Snack</u>

The children receive free fruit every day to enjoy at playtime. They should also bring in a drink of **water** in a labelled bottle.



Maths

In maths this term we will be working on:

- number and place value,
- addition and subtraction and number bonds
- shape, position and direction and measurement

This term our topic is 'Crazy Castles'.

Our Discovery Curriculum has a cross-curricular approach to teaching and learning and takes into account what the children know and would like to know. At the end of the topic we will complete a chamion challenge where the children will use all the skills they have learnt to complete a group task.
