<u>Homework</u>

Homework will be set on on a **Monday afternoon** to be completed and given in by the following Monday. The Maths and English tasks are usually related to the work that we have been doing that week. These activities should be completed in about 10 - 20 minutes with minimal adult support and are an important part of your child's learning through consolidation.

<u>Spellings</u>

Spellings are now given through the EdShed platform. 10 spellings will be set and learnt each week. A new spelling list is set each Monday and the children are given time each day to practice whilst at school alongside a weekly spelling lesson. Everybody will have their spelling test on a Friday. Your child may well know their EdShed password by heart. Alternatively, this may be or can be stuck to the inside back cover of their reading records.

Take Away Homework

Our takeaway homework this term is linked to our Discovery Curriculum topic of Wonders of the deep! This will be sent home separately.

Reading Books

Reading books will be changed as and when needed so please ensure your child brings their signed reading records and books to school every day.

<u>PE</u>

PE will be on a **Tuesday.** Please ensure that your child comes to school in their PE kit on this day. Earrings should not be worn and long hair should be tied back.

Swimming will go ahead every Thursday morning.

<u>Snack</u>

The children can bring in a fruit snack for break time and a labelled water bottle to use throughout the day.

<u>English</u>

This term we will focus on:

- Reading and comprehension—from facts to inference.
- Writing non-fiction texts with appropriate features and vocabulary.
- Poetry
- We will continue to focus on sentence construction and punctuation.



Discovery Curriculum

This term our main topic will be The Wonders of the Deep. We will be learning about the oceans and seas of the world both geographically and ecologically.

We will continue to teach subjects through our Discovery Curriculum which has a cross-curricular approach to teaching and learning.

At the end of topic we will complete a 'Champion Challenge', where the children will use all of the skills that they have learnt to complete a group challenge.

<u>Maths</u>

The areas of maths that we will cover this term include:

- Multiplication and Division
- Measure
- Fractions
- Properties of shapes
- Statistics



<u>Science</u>

As part of our Discovery topic, our science work will focus on:

- Plants
- Light
- Wonders of the Deep
