Take-Away Homework

This term the take-away homework is based on our topic 'Epic Egyptians.' The take-away menu and letter will provide more information on this.

<u>Spellings</u>

Spellings are now set on Mondays on Spelling Shed and tested on Fridays on Spelling Shed. They practise this for 15 minutes daily at school and we encourage the children to practise at home too if able. Their spelling score will be written into their reading diary on their reading day. Spellings will begin on the week commencing 06/09.

<u>Reading</u>

Books are changed on the children's reading day. These days will be shared with your children next week, and will be written in their reading

records. Please ensure your child brings their reading record to school every day, indicating the reading they have done during the week. If your child has read other books at home, please record this in the back of their reading records.



<u>English</u>

In English this term we will focus on the following:

- A narrative, an explanation text and a myth.
- Regular punctuation and grammar sessions relating to the year 4 national curriculum.
- A range of spelling rules that link to the children's home spellings.



Discovery Curriculum

The topic this term is 'Epic Egyptians.'

- History- What was life like in Ancient Egypt?
- Science– States of Matter, Electricity
- RE Christianity Christmas
- PSHE- Being me in my world
- ICT Online safety
- DT / Art Activities linked to the Egyptians.

We will be celebrating our topic with an Egyptian day towards the end of this term where the children might like to come in costume. A date for this event will come out nearer the time.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this term we will focus on the following:

- Place value of number
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Division
