Welcome back to a new term. The purpose of this newsletter is to outline important procedures, many of which are similar to previous terms.

Homework

Homework in year 1 consists of three parts: reading, NumBots practice and spellings. The children also have an opportunity to choose something to create from a 'Takeaway homework menu' that they can present at the end of Spring term.

Reading

Reading books will be changed on a **Thursday**. Please fill in your child's reading record with comment to let us know how they got on each time they read to you. **Books will be changed once the child has read the book a few times at home.**

NumBots

A NumBots login is stuck inside the front cover of reading record. This a game ideal for supporting your child's number fluency and recall of facts.

Spellings and High Frequency words

Arrangements for **Spellings and high frequency words** will continue to be the same as last term. The children's spelling days will stay the same.

Take Away Homework

Each term a 'menu' of creative activities are sent home as a homework project to be completed by the end of the term. These are an opportunity for the children to make something linked to that term's topic.

Additional word practice

Each week the children will receive some words containing a specific sound that they may need some additional help to learn. A few words read each day after school should be enough practice to help them secure any sounds they are not yet confident with.

This term's topic is 'T-Rex on Tour'.



English

In English lessons this term, we will be continuing to look at sentence structure and the use of simple punctuation, whilst improving our stamina for writing.

We will develop our:

- Composition of sentences both orally and written
- Use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Use of correct tense- simple past or present
- Use of exclamation and question marks
- Use of co-ordinating and sub-ordinating conjunctions

PE

PE will be on a **Thursday**. Please ensure that your child comes dressed for PE on Thursdays. **They will stay in their PE kits all day**. Earrings should not be worn on this day and long hair should be tied back.

Snack

*The children receive free fruit every day to enjoy at playtime. They should also bring in a drink of **water** in a labelled bottle.*

Maths

In maths this term we will be working on:

- *measurements including: mass, volume and time,*
- *Counting, unitising and coins*
- *Geometry*

T-Rex on Tour

This term our topic is 'T-Rex on Tour' .

Our Curriculum activities has a cross-curricular approach to teaching and learning and takes into account what the children know and would like to know.
