When you are able to listen to your child read, please make sure you are asking questions about what is being read, especially inference-level questions.

# **English**

*In English this term we will focus on the following:* 

- A narrative
- A recount
- Poetry



#### **Discovery Curriculum**

Our main topic this term is Magical Rainforests. The learning journey for this topic will include:

- Locating rainforests on maps and globes.
- Identifying which biomes rainforests belong to and what climates they have.
- Identifying the features and layers of a rainforest.
- Looking at animals that live in rainforests, their habitats and their population.
- Studying examples of tribes that still lead a traditional life in rainforests.
- Deforestation and the effect it is having on people, animals, plants and the surrounding areas.

#### Maths

In Maths this term we will focus on the following:

- Times tables
- Multiplication
- Division
- Symmetry
- Time

We will continuously be working on the recall of all times tables in preparation for the times table test in June.
