Homework

*Homework will begin next week (10/9). Homework is handed out on **Monday** and should be returned to school on the following **Monday**. Homework this term will consist of the following:*

Maths (every day). The children will be given a new fluency booklet each half term which will be stuck into the back of their homework book. There are tasks for each school day of the week. The tasks need to be completed daily and are to be returned with other homework on a Monday. The maths lesson starters will link to the work the children complete in class so please don't rush ahead as this will cause confusion!

Spellings

Commas- Thursday

Reading

Books are changed as and when necessary. Please ensure your child brings their reading record to school every day, indicating the reading they have done during the week.

English

In English this term we will focus on the following:

- *Writing a range of non-fiction with appropriate features and vocabulary.*
- *Grammatical terminology and improving sentence construction.*
- *Spelling rules*



Maths

In Maths this term we will focus on the following:

- *Place value.*
- *Formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.*
- *Fractions*
- *Rapid recall of all times tables*



Discovery Curriculum

Our main topic this term is World War 2.

Many of the Foundation subjects will be linked to this topic. The children will help to create their learning journey for this topic but the learning will include :

- *Exploring why the war started and the countries involved.*
- *Understanding some of the significant events of the war.*
- *Understanding what life was like for people living in Britain during the war and how they might have felt.*
- *Understanding the term propaganda and exploring posters.*
- *Using a range of resources to understand the past and recognise how some sources can have limitations in terms of accuracy and relevance.*

PE

This year PE will occur on Thursday afternoons. Please ensure PE kits are in school for every Thursday. PE is a compulsory part of the school curriculum and your child MUST have a letter if they are unable to participate in this subject.

SATS

These tests will occur in the week beginning 13th May 2019. There will be a meeting on the tests in nearer the time.
