Homework

Spellings

Spellings will begin in the week commencing 29/04/19. Ten spellings will be learnt each week. Correct spellings are highlighted and the 'unhighlighted' ones are to be part of the ten for the next week.

Reading

The children are able to change their books as and when they are finished with their previous one. It is essential that the children write in their records every time they read. The children are expected to read and write this in their records at least once a week as this has a huge impact on their reading and own writing. If this is not completed, the children will stay in with me at a break time to read.

We are now completing more and more inference questions within our reading, and lots of us are finding this quite tricky, so any questions you can ask when you child reads to you to check their understanding would be a huge help.

English

In English this term we will focus on the following:

- Narrative Structure : writing narratives in the form of a script.
- Spoken language: Debates
- Poetry
- Non Fiction: News reports

Through these units important grammar, sentence and punctuation objectives will be taught as well as understanding of complex sentences and a wider use of connectives.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this term the focus will be on the following :

- Geometry—angles and shapes
- Measurement—converting units
- Area and perimeter
- Volume
- Time
