Welcome back to the summer term! I hope you had a wonderful Easter holiday.

Reading

The children continue to make great progress with their reading and it is lovely to see their enthusiasm when they receive new books. Please fill in your child's reading record each time they read to you. Books will only be changed if there is an entry in their record book. Children should now be stopping and self-correcting if something does not make sense and should be using their phonic knowledge- not guessing words. They should also be pausing at commas and full stops. Also, please spend some time asking the children questions about their reading to check their comprehension.

<u>Please make sure children have their reading wallet in school every day so we</u> can fit in extra reads wherever possible.

Homework Tasks

We will continue to send home a weekly fluency text for the children to practise before performing in Thursday's assembly. This is really having a great impact on expression and automaticity.

Please continue to share the **phonic books and bookmarks** that come home each week so you can reinforce the spelling patterns we teach at school. Remember, these have been completed independently with just a quick glance from me rather than detailed marking, so children may have made the odd error.

Spellings

Many children have now learnt lots of the words on their personalised spelling lists in the back of the reading record books and some have already begun the next lists. Please keep practising these and ticking when you feel your child knows them by heart at which point I will test them at school. New lists will be added when required. Even if you haven't started learning these at home - it's never too late to start!
